The Sports Chanbara European Championship is a competition exclusively for Nations. Consequently, obviously, the following are NOT expected to participate:

- 2/3 national delegations per country
- Individual clubs
- Autonomous athletes

ITALY A and ITALY B

FRANCE A and FRANCE B

ITALY and Club Accademia Ischia

FRANCE and Club Chanbara Macon

One and only one National Organization from each single European Country can take part in the European Championship.



## **SCHEDULE AND REGULATION:**

The Kihon Dousa Individuals competition (All Categories) and Kihon Dousa National Team competition (Category Q) will take place on Saturday June 08<sup>th</sup> 2024.

#### > Kihon Dousa Individuals:

- Every competitor may choose to use any weapon.
- Kihon Dousa Grand Champion will be held among the winners of all Categories.

#### > Kihon Dousa National Team:

- One Team per Country.
- 3 Competitors per Team (all ages, all graduations).
- Competitors may choose to use any weapon.

#### > Draws:

• All matches will be drawn using a computerized system until the finals. Draw system is designed to prevent matches between athletes from the same country, if possible, up to the semifinals.

The Datotsu Individuals competition + Grand Champion (from Categories A-B-C-M-N-O-P) will take place on Saturday June 08<sup>th</sup> 2024.

The Datotsu Individuals competition + Grand Champion (from Categories D-E-F-G-H-I-L) and Datotsu National Team competition (Categories R-S-T-U) will take place on Sunday June 09<sup>th</sup> 2024.



#### > Datotsu Individuals:

- Each competitor can choose a maximum of 3 weapons.
- All fights will follow Shobu Ippon rule until the Quarter Finals and will last 1 minute and 30 seconds with a 30 seconds extension in case of a tie.
- Semifinals and Finals will follow Shobu Sanbon rule. The first AIUCHI will count 1-1. Semifinals and Finals will last 3 minutes with a 30 seconds extension in case of a tie.
- No competitor will be eliminated in case of repeated AIUCHI. There must always be a winner.
- A weapon specialty to be held must be composed by at least 4 competitors, otherwise it will be cancelled and merged with other weapon specialties.
- Winners of each weapon specialties in each category will compete for the Grand Champion Tournament.
- All Grand Champion fights will follow the Shobu Sanbon rule. The first AIUCHI counts 1-1. The fights will last 3 minutes. In case of draw, time will be extended for further 30 seconds.
- Each competitor will keep the weapon with which he won.

#### > Datotsu National Team:

- One Team per Country, composed by 3 competitors (1 Kodachi + 1 Choken Free + 1 Nito).
- Once you have set the Team, you cannot modify its composition during the competition.
- No Country alliance will be allowed.
- Datotsu National Team competition will follow the Shobu Ippon rule. The fights will last for 1 minute and 30 seconds. The first AIUCHI or a draw after the end of the time (in this case won't be a time extension), will count 1-1. In case of a tie, after 3 fights, one component of each Team will fight one more time with Choken Free Style.

## > Referees:

• Each country should present a minimum of 2 Referees.



## **GENERAL INFORMATIONS**

## > Equipment:

- ✓ You should use your *National Uniform*, ideally a Sports Chanbara Uniform (sleeveless). The color of the shirt must be the same for all combatants of the same country.
- ✓ Feet are naked, EXCEPT medically justified protection and authorization of the Referees.
- ✓ *The wearing of gloves (without rigid frame) is recommended.*
- ✓ Weapons and Kyu Men approved by ISCA.
- ✓ The Organizers reserve the right to examine and exclude weapons that seem to question the form, maintenance condition, weight, height and not enough pumped up.

## > Global Organization

## ✓ During competitions:

- Shoes are not allowed in the Competition Area.
- Supporters must stay in the stands and will not be able to access the Competition Area.

## ✓ During fights:

- Only the athletes competing at that time must be present within the perimeter of the Competition Area.
- In case of disagreement, any external intervention (except that of a federal executive) will not be tolerated.
- The decisions belong to the Referees.
